

Harney County Library Window/Door Replacement Project Advertisement for Request for Quotes

Tasks to be completed:

1. Replace all windows at the Library with:
 - Windows must be an Energy Star Partner and meet Oregon Department of Energy requirements
 - Proposals shall be itemized and prepared based on the project drawings, specification, and schedule of door/window sizes

2. Replace designated exterior doors at the Library with the following requirements:
 - Doors must be Energy Star Partner and meet Oregon Department of Energy requirements
 - Include all door handles, hinges, locks and other accessories that make doors fully operational
 - If doors currently have glass within the door, the replacements must also have glass

PARTIAL SUMMARY OF CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS

LOCATION - The Library is located at 80 West D Street, Burns, Oregon. Contractors are encouraged to visit the site prior to requesting additional information.

DEADLINE - Quotes must be submitted in a sealed envelope no later than Monday, March 10, 2010, 5 p.m. to Harney County Courthouse (450 N. Buena Vista, Burns, Oregon 97720). No fax documents will be accepted.

DAVIS-BACON ACT/PREVAILING WAGE - The Contractor acknowledges to abide by the Davis-Bacon Act which requires that all laborers and mechanics employed by contractors and subcontractors on projects funded in whole or in part with funds available under ARRA must be paid wages at rates not less than those prevailing on projects of a similar character in the locality, as determined by the United State Secretary of Labor under subchapter IV of chapter 31 of title 40 of the United States Code. The United States Secretary of Labor's determination, regarding the prevailing wages applicable in the State of Oregon is located at: <http://www.gpo.gov/davisbacon/or.html>. Payroll records must be submitted every Monday morning no later than 10 a.m. for time spent on this project for all employees once the project begins.

BUY AMERICAN – Contractor or subcontracts will use ARRA funds for a project for the construction, alteration, maintenance or repair of a public building or public work unless all of the iron, steel and manufactured goods used in the project are produced in the United States. This requirement is set forth in Section 1606 of ARRA. Forms will be required to prove that materials used on this project are in compliance with the Buy American portion of the contract.
